Rules of the Derby

Measuring & Photo Documenting

- Measurements must be on a valid measuring board
- Rainbow trout should be recorded immediately, and measurements noted by length
- All submissions must include 2 photographs: 1) A pic of you holding the fish 2) A pic of the fish on the measuring board
- Close the fish's mouth. The nose should touch the bump of the measuring board (belly facing you). This photo needs to include the entire fish on the board.
- If the fish tail is touching the graduation line on the board then that is the exact measurement. If the tail crosses a graduation line, round up 1/8th.
- All participants must have their fish submitted by 4:15pm on the day of the derby. For a Fish-On exemption to apply, you must contact your derby judge no later than 4pm.

Measuring Boards

1 per boat will be provided upon check-in. Check in will take place the Friday before your Derby date. Location TBD. Last year's measuring boards can only be used with an **updated 2024 sticker**. Please contact your derby director for more information, and to get your new 2024 sticker.

Derby Director

Your Derby Director for the Shuswap Lake is Mandy Davis. Your Derby Director for the Okanagan Lake is Mike Bridge. Contact numbers to be provided after registration and payment are received. All decisions made by the tournament director are final.

Sportsmanship

All participants are expected to follow high standards of sportsmanship, courtesy, safety and conservation. Any participant who displays poor sportsmanship, violates these rules or brings unfavorable publicity to the sport of fishing could be disqualified.

Body of Water

Participants must fish in the area specified for the event. Fishing has to be legal and in public waters only: no private ponds, streams, lakes or rivers. Participants may fish in any water that is open to public fishing, on the lake specified at registration

Tiebreakers

Tiebreakers will be determined by flipping of a coin. The person who submitted their photo first will be the one to call "heads or tails".

Claiming Prizes

Ensure that your correct address, email, and mobile number appear on your registration for prize announcements and delivery. Prizes are the responsibility of the winners. Transportation, taxes, and incidentals are the responsibility of the winner. It is the responsibility of the derby director to disburse all prizes.

Laws and Regulations

All federal, provincial, and local laws and all fishing and boating rules must be abided by. All participants must follow the water specific regulations for the Shuswap Lake and/or Okanagan Lake. All participants must have a valid BC Recreational Freshwater Fishing License (if applicable) All boat owners must comply with the rules and regulations as set out by Transport Canada. Failure to comply with any tournament rules subjects participants to disqualification and removal from the competition, as determined by the tournament officials.

Cheating

All protests must be brought to the director's attention before the end of the event. Anyone caught breaking the law or disobeying the rules will be disqualified. Fish must be hooked and caught live in a conventional manner. Fish can not be snagged, netted, speared, etc.

Safety

Participants are responsible for their own safety, actions, and property at all times. Each entrant, upon registration to compete in the derby, agrees that he/she will not hold the Sponsors or Hosts liable for any kind of accident that might occur during the fishing derby. The Derby is on the water of Shuswap Lake or Okanagan Lake, whichever the registrant chooses.

By signing below, you are declaring that you have read and understand the rules of the derby. You are aware that you are responsible for your guests on board your boat, and that in no way are the organizers, sponsors, donors or anyone affiliated to the derby be held responsible for any liability issue that may arise while participating in Brewed in Canada's 3rd Annual Fishing Derby. It is the responsibility of the registered boat owner to ensure that all persons onboard their personal watercraft are following the rules of the derby, are licensed accordingly, and are adhering to all Transport Canada's rules and regulations.
